## Major Disruptions to Bus Service Expected Sunday Due to Des Moines Marathon

The Des Moines Area Regional Transit Authority (DART) anticipates major disruptions to bus service on the morning of Sunday, October 21, due to street closures for the Des Moines Marathon.

- Routes 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 11 will be on detour through downtown Des Moines.
- The primary downtown transfer point is being temporarily relocated to Mulberry Street from the Walnut Street Transit Mall from 8 a.m. to noon that day. Transfers cannot be guaranteed during this time.
- Service to the East Village will be suspended all day.
