DART Suspends Bus Service until 11:45 a.m.

Bus service has been suspended through 11:45 a.m. this morning by the Des Moines Area Regional Transit Authority.

The unusually high amounts of snowfall and downed power lines are hampering efforts to clear major streets, presenting a very difficult environment in which operate service safely.

DART plans to resume service on local routes at 11:45 a.m. out of DART Central Station. Express routes will be suspended all day.

The suspension of service is rare, having occurred only two times prior in the past two decades -- once for the flood of 1993 and a second time during a 2009 blizzard.
