

#### Introduction

- DART is proposing the realignment of Local Route 5 – Franklin Avenue and Local Route 51 – Merle Hay Crosstown into a single new route.
- The new route will be a service improvement, helping to connect more people to more places, more often.


#### Route 5 - Franklin Avenue



#### **Route 5 Summary**

- ▶ Service hours: 6:15 8:45 a.m. / 3:45-6:30 p.m.
- Frequency: 3 morning and 3 afternoon trips / 60 minute service
- ► Trip time: 21-22 minutes depending on time of day and direction of travel


## Route 51 - Merle Hay Crosstown




### **Route 51 Summary**

- ▶ Service hours: 6 a.m. 6:15 p.m.
- ▶ Frequency: 30 minute peak, 60 minute midday
- ► Trip time: 23-28 minutes depending on time of day and direction of travel

# New Proposed Route and Discontinued Routing



#### **New Proposed Route Summary**

- Routing: Connects DART Central Station to Merle Hay Mall via Ingersoll Avenue, MLKJr. Parkway, Woodland Avenue, 31st Street, 30th Street, Clark Street, 34th Street, Franklin Avenue and Merle Hay Road.
- ▶ Service hours: 6 a.m. to 6:45 p.m.
- Frequency: 60 minute
- ► Trip time: 27-32 minutes depending on time of day and direction of travel

## Why Realign Routes?

- Connect more people to more places based on:
  - Improved accessibility
  - Ridership data and indicators
  - Area demographics
  - Traffic conditions

### **Benefits: Connecting People**

- New routing along Woodland Avenue and 31st Street provides more accessibility to people with transportation needs:
  - Callanan Middle School on 31st Street
  - Scottish Rite Park Senior Living Center on Woodland Avenue
  - Child Serve on Woodland Avenue
  - Drake University neighborhoods along 31st Street

#### **Benefits: Improved Connections**

- New connection with Route 60 via Ingersoll
- New/improved connections with Routes 3 and Routes 60 via University

#### **Benefits: Increase Service Hours**

- ▶ 6 a.m. to 6:45 p.m.
  - Provides midday service to current Route5 riders
  - Provides extended hours to current Route51 riders
- Every 60 minutes
- Opportunity to build service hours in future

#### **Proposed Timeline**

- April Public meetings and review of public feedback
- May Present final recommendation of service change to commission for approval
- July Informational meetings
- August Service implemented
