DART Service Changes Go Into Effect on Sunday

A series of minor service changes by the Des Moines Area Regional Transit Authority will go into effect on Sunday, June 12, to better service customers.

- Schedule times will be adjusted on Routes 3, 6, 7, 8 and 11.
- Route 3 (University/Highland Oak Park) – The Roosevelt High School loop will be suspended for the summer.
- Route 11 (Ingersoll/West Des Moines) – A primary boarding location in Valley Junction has been moved to Elm and 5th Street. This new “time point” will be reflected in the updated schedule.

New schedules will be available online at www.ridedart.com and on DART buses by Wednesday, June 8.

The next scheduled service change will be in August.
